SCHEDULE

Sunday, April 12, 3:30 Registration, 4:00 pm to 6:30 pm Welcome Party

The Welcome Party will be a fun event! Nancy Sartor and Deb Finn are planning another great party this year with lively music, great food and more. This evening will be your chance to view all the items in the Raffle and Silent Auction in the Coyote Rooms, as well as pick up your tee prizes at the Registration table. Tickets for the Cash Raffle and Item Raffle will be on sale today, and you can bid on the Silent Auction items. You will not want to miss this! The Pro Shop will be open until 6:00 pm for your and your guests' convenience, with a 25% discount on soft goods Sunday afternoon through Tuesday afternoon.

Monday, April 13, 8:00 am Shotgun

Day One of the tournament. The format for Day One is a Shamble (non-postable), and we have an 8:00 am shotgun start to be played on the Saddlebrooke/Tucson courses. Buffet lunch follows immediately in the Vistas Dining Room. Tickets for the Cash Raffle and Raffle items will be on sale through lunch. Day Two of the tournament. The format for Day Two is a Better Ball of Partners (non-postable) to be played on the SaddleBrooke/Tucson courses with an 8:00 am shotgun start. The awards lunch follows immediately in the Vistas Dining Room. Flight prizes, Raffle and Silent Auction item winnings will be distributed and cash winners will be drawn.

PRACTICE ROUNDS

Practice rounds will be available beginning Sunday, April 5 at a cost of \$50 per player. Call the Pro Shop directly any time after March 30 for reservations and mention the Quail Classic.
