AZ Golf has a great schedule this year! For those of you who like to travel, the Women's Championship events are being held at some beautiful courses around the state. The full schedule on the AZ Golf website. The 2026 events that have been most popular with our league in past years are:

For those of you who prefer to play close to home, AZ Golf has a new event, the Cloud Series, that you can play right here at SaddleBrooke! The Cloud Series is a fun and social way to play competitive golf on your own schedule. It's a two-person team challenge held monthly from February to May. You pick your playing partner and the Arizona golf course and tees to play. Compete against others throughout the state of Arizona using the Golf Genius platform to enter your scores. Once registration closes, a GGID will be emailed and allows you to enter your scores. Each month's format will alternate between a Four-Ball format and an Aggregate Score format. The monthly challenges are based on net scores.

This Series is open to all AZ GOLF members with an established Handicap Index. Players pick their teammate for each monthly challenge and are responsible for paying their own green fees for each challenge. You may only play the challenge once each month and you may only play on one team per month. It's not necessary for teams to play with other Cloud Series participants.

The winning team from each monthly challenge will receive a prize, and four players from the field will be randomly selected to receive an AZ GOLF prize.
