

XI. SPECIAL TOURNAMENTS

The following Standing Rules are applicable to all Special Tournaments:

1. If a Chair/Co-Chair does not volunteer for running the event three (3) months prior to the date of the event, the tournament will be cancelled for that year and the play dates reserved will be released to the Pro Shop.
2. Standing Rules and SBWGA-18 Local Rules (i.e., Section VII) in effect at the time of a tournament may not be waived without the approval of the Rules Committee and the current Board of Officers.
3. Prize money for special tournaments is funded by the entry fees and supplemented by sponsor money if available.
4. All entrants will play to a maximum course handicap of 36.
5. For partner events: handicap differential between partners may not be more than 10 strokes. If the playing handicap between the two players is greater than 10 strokes, the playing handicap for the player with the higher handicap will be reduced. Scrambles and Shambles may be excepted from this rule as percentages of handicaps are used per USGA Rules of Handicapping.
6. Players must provide a current established and verifiable handicap index to be eligible.
7. With the agreement of the current Board, the Chair(s) and Committee will:
 - a. establish entry procedures
 - b. determine the field size and format
 - c. determine the method of substitution in the event of cancellation
8. THREE JILLS & A JACK TOURNAMENT
 - a. Three Jills & A Jack is a one-day annual event for three SBWGA-18 members and any man who is an HOA #1 or HOA #2 verifiable resident with a current established USGA Handicap Index. All entrants will play to a maximum course handicap of 36.
9. QUAIL CLASSIC INVITATIONAL
 - a. This is a two-day member-guest event. Guests may not be members of SBWGA-18.
 - b. SBWGA-18 members who have not paid annual golf fees are required to pay green fees as they would any time they play the golf course.
 - c. The Chair(s) for the following year shall be appointed by the President and the current Board.

10. MEMBER-MEMBER TOURNAMENT

- a. This is a two-day eclectic tournament held biennially on odd-numbered years.

11. SADDLEBROOKE WOMEN'S CLASSIC

- a. This tournament is hosted by each club every third year
- b. This reciprocal event is for members of SBWGA-18, Mountain View/Preserve Women's Golf Association-18 and SaddleBrooke Ranch WGA-18.
- c. All entrants will play to a maximum course handicap of 36.

12. GUEST DAY

- a. This is a one-day tournament where SBWGA-18 members are encouraged to ask members of other local clubs to partner with them in this fun event.
- b. Team Best Ball Format: flights of teams will be determined by team handicap.

13. LAGOS TOURNAMENT (Ladies Amalgamated Golf Of SaddleBrooke)

- a. LAGOS is a cooperative event with the SaddleBrooke Lady Niners.
- b. Responsibility for this tournament rotates between the SBWGA-18 and the SaddleBrooke Lady Niners. The SBWGA-18 will host this event on odd-numbered years.

14. "SOLHEIM TYPE" TOURNAMENT

- a. This is a two-day team match play event held biennially on even-numbered years.
